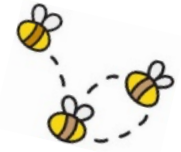

## WELCOME BACK TO Leaside Memorial Gardens Pool

- Caregivers should be accompanying children in the water and be within arm's reach at all times.
- All swimmers 9yrs and under will be given an orange wrist band upon entry into the pool. If they wish to enter the deep end of the pool they must pass the facility swim test. The test requirements are 2 widths of the pool, face in the water (front swim) done to the lifeguard's satisfaction. Once completed they will be issued a green wrist band.
- Children, who are not toilet trained, must wear snug fitting pants over a cotton diaper or suitable infant disposable swim pants. (e.g. Gabby's Pool Pant Diaper, Huggies Little Swimmers)
- Lockers are for day use only and are available on a first come basis. Please ensure you bring a lock to lock up personal belongs and **NEVER LEAVE THEM UNATTENDED!** The City of Toronto does not accept responsibility for damage, loss or theft of personal items.
- Food, beverages and outdoor shoes are not permitted on the pool deck.
- All change rooms are intended to be used by both male and female patrons. Appropriate bathing attire must be worn at all times in the shower and open areas of the change room. Cubicles must be used when changing. **ALL MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC HAVE ACCESS TO THIS AREA.**
- All patrons **MUST** exit the change room **WITHIN 10 MINUTES** after programs

### Admittance Policy

The admittance policy addresses age and swimming ability to determine whether individuals may be admitted to the aquatic facility and whether they require accompaniment. Supervision ratio requirements are listed in the table.

Non swimmers must be directly supervised by their caregiver who must remain within arm's reach and able to render immediate assistance
